Jackson Dean to perform at U.P. State Fair Tuesday, Aug. 15



ESCANABA - The U.P. State Fair is pleased to announce the first act of its full line-up of grandstand entertainment this year, presented by Island Resort and Casino. Fast-rising country singer/songwriter Jackson Dean will take the U.P. State Fair Grandstand stage on Tuesday,

Quickly earning a reputation for his old school, gritty, lyric-driven, outlaw style of Country, Jackson Dean is mature beyond his years. He opted to move out to a cinderblock, concrete floor, oneroom shack on the back of his grandfather's property with no heat and no plumbing at just 18 years old. An adventurous and carefree spirit, the 22-yearold multi-instrumentalist is also an old

soul and skilled artisan whose pastimes include making leather goods, wood-burned art, and disappearing into the woods to sleep under the stars. Bringing that same sense of adventure and down-home vibe to his songwriting, the "modern-day Country rambler" (Taste of Country) burst on the scene, showing people how real music can be with his atmospheric, musically-forward debut album "Greenbroke" (out now via Big Machine Records). The Maryland native's single, "Don't Come Lookin" was the fastest debut to reach No. one in 2022 and cemented Jackson as the youngest solo male Country artist to reach the top of the charts with a debut.

Following an early career of local performances in his hometown, Jackson Dean has joined bills with superstar acts like Toby Keith, Miranda Lambert, Brantley Gilbert, Kane Brown, Jake Owen, Brooks & Dunn, Lee Brice and Brothers Osborne, and found himself on the bill for events like Austin City Limits and Stagecoach.

Growing UP Foresters Exhibit

Escanaba - For more than a decade, the Growing U.P. Foresters exhibit in the Miracle of life building on the Upper Peninsula State Fairgrounds has enthralled and educated youth with information and fun activities about the forest and the forest products industry.

A staple at the fiar, the exhibit is an interactive experience that allows guests of all ages to learn information about forestry, the paper-making process, forest management, and forest animals as they go on a "hike" through the forest-like display.


Along the way, visitors are shown educational videos and participate in fun activities that show the importance of the forest to even the youngest of fairgoers.

The primary goals of the exhibit are to highlight the importance of the forest to the Upper Peninsula by showing how the forest products industry impacts the local economy and to remind visitors that many of the products they use every day come from forests.

The exhibit shows how forest products come from hard-working professional supplying timber or producing products such as paper. Besides showing how to be good stewards of the forest themselves, the exhibit aims to impact to guests that there are good, well-paying jobs available in the forest products industry on many levels and to spark the interest that will raise up the next generation of forest products professionals.

After many years of being a feature of the fair, the Growing U.P. Foresters exhibit found a permanent home in the Miracle of Life Building. The building allows for more exposure to the exhibit - particularly to families that may be visiting the baby animals that share the Miracle of Life Building with the exhibit during the fair - and allows for the exhibit to maintain a more authentic forest feel.

The result has been a boost in the number of visitors to the exhibit and a greater understand of the forest and forest products industry as a whole.

Ashley McBryde to perform at U.P. State Fair Thursday, Aug. 17

ESCANABA - Grammy, CMA and ACM Award winner Ashley McBryde will take the Grandstand stage at the U.P. State Fair on Thursday, Aug. 17. Ashley McBryde is the fifth act announced by the U.P. State Fair in its full line-up of grandstand entertainment this year, presented by Island Resort and Casino.

Ashley McBryde cut her teeth playing country songs in rural biker bars — and it shows. The Grand Ole Opry member's 2018 major label debut "Girl Going Nowhere" (Warner Music Nashville) charmed The New York Times, NPR, Rolling Stone, Paste, The Washington Post and more, all en route to landing a Grammy nomination for Best Country Album.

McBryde closed out 2019 with ACM New Female Artist, CMT Breakout Artist, a New Artist of the Year win at the 53rd Annual CMA Awards and two nominations for the 2020 Grammys for Best Country Song and Best Country Solo Performance for "Girl Goin' Nowhere." Her follow-up "Never Will" was tagged by Rolling Stone as one of the most anticipated of the year alongside NPR, who also ranked her Top 10 RIAA Platinum-Certified single "One Night Standards" as one of the best songs of 2019. The album earned McBryde a 2021 Grammy nomination for Best Country Album, making "Never Will" the only album nominated for Country Album of the Year by the ACMs, CMAs and the Recording Academy in the same award season. Her Grammy-winning duet with Carly Pearce, "Never Wanted To Be That Girl," went all the way to No. 1 and earned McBryde and Pearce the ACM and CMA award for Musical Event of the Year. McBryde was also honored with the 2022 CMA International Artist Achievement Award for the most significant creative growth, development and promotion of the country music industry outside of the United States.
